Follow the instructions and send your facemask to the EAST COAST office at Green Gridiron, Inc., 1226 Donaldson Road, Greenville, SC 29605 (the West Coast office only handles large orders) AND MAKE SURE YOU SPECIFY THE COLOR TO: Green Bay Gold / Yellow.

Personal Helmet Reconditioning

*****Warning, this process takes weeks!!!*****

--Do not wait until the last minute...

Santa Clarita Cowboys follows the National Operating Committee on Standards for Athletic Equipment (NOCSAE) recommendation "that organizations adopt and follow a program of helmet inspection and reconditioning that meets their particular needs, based on age and size of players, severity of helmet usage, ages of helmets, among other

factors. Some schools recondition and recertify their football helmets every year, some every two years.”

Parents that own a personal helmet for their player need to have the helmet recertified if they want the player to play football in their personal helmet.

Note: Santa Clarita Cowboys does not turn any personal helmets (helmets owned by individual players) in for reconditioning. Santa Clarita Cowboys only turns helmets owned by the Santa Clarita Cowboys organization itself in for reconditioning/repainting/recertification. To turn your personal helmet in for reconditioning/repainting/recertification be aware that Riddell Corporation is the only authorized company to use as they are the only ones to paint helmets our color (Forest

Green Metallic 002740)—**MAKE SURE THAT YOU TELL RIDDELL TO PAINT YOUR HELMET THE CORRECT COLOR!—**

although some Santa Clarita Cowboys helmets are not yet the forest green metallic color, we will within one year transition all of our helmets over to being painted the same forest green metallic color.

HOW TO GET YOUR HELMET RECONDITIONED AND RECERTIFIED BY RIDDELL

Annual Reconditioning and Recertification is Recommended for Every Helmet

- **1. CALL RIDDELL AT 1-888-681-1717.** Ask for Anthony Colangel. He will help you initiate the Reconditioning and Recertification process.
- **2. SEND US YOUR HELMET** Riddell will email you an evaluation form along with a pre-paid shipping label.
- **3. INSPECTION** We will evaluate your helmet and call you with an exact price before any work is done.
- **4. RECONDITIONING AND RECERTIFICATION** Includes cleaning, sanitizing, buffing/painting/color changes, inspection, repairs and NOCSAE certification.
- **5. GO PLAY** Your helmet is returned fully reconditioned, recertified and ready for the next season.

- **MANUFACTURER CERTIFIES PRODUCT MEETS NOCSAE® PERFORMANCE STANDARDS**

It's never too early to start thinking about next year - please read before shipping an item to Riddell for reconditioning and recertification.

Never send an item to Riddell for reconditioning without first speaking to a representative of the Riddell Consumer Services Team.

Riddell is not responsible for any items sent without the proper paperwork, including the evaluation form used in your inspection.

All interior pieces should remain intact and inside your helmet when shipping for reconditioning.

Please remove all chinstraps, visors/eye shields & mouthguards prior to shipping any helmets.

These items will be discarded upon receipt. Riddell is not responsible for any helmet accessories received along with reconditioning orders.

Face masks may be left attached to helmets sent in for reconditioning.

Face masks are inspected but are not reconditioned. A face mask deemed unsuitable for play during inspection will be noted during your follow-up call. You will have the opportunity to add a new face mask to your reconditioning order for an additional cost at this time.

Individual reconditioning orders average 4 weeks turnaround.

What is "reconditioning and recertification"?

Reconditioning and recertification is the process in which your equipment is cleaned, sanitized, buffed, painted (or re-painted), inspected, repaired and NOCSAE certified. In that order.

What should I include in the box when I send my helmet in?

Please send your fully-assembled helmet with all interior parts intact. **DO NOT** include any accessories - chinstraps, eye shields/visors or mouthguards - as these are discarded upon receipt. Face masks will be inspected, though not reconditioned, and can be left attached to your helmet.
